1. When (d) comes before (g), (d) is silent and interferes with the Magic E and the first vowel remains short:

bădge, lědge, rĭdge

u

1. When (u) comes after (g) and before (e), (i) or (y), the (u) is silent and interferes with the (e), (i), or (y) and the (g) can say /guh/:

guild, guitar, guess

2. When (u) comes between (c) and (i), the (u) is silent and interferes with (i) so the (c) can imitate /k/:

biscuit, circuit
